## **This Week's Hot Topics**

- PORK CONSOLIDATION Brazil's JBS S.A, the world's largest meatpacker, said Wednesday that its U.S-based subsidiary Swift Pork Co. has entered in an agreement to buy Cargill Inc.'s pork businesses in the U.S. for \$1.45 billion. That includes the firm's Beardstown processing plant.
- GLUTTED MARKET Agricultural prices face a 10-year bear market, says the OECD. That is bad news for companies supplying tractors and fertilizer.
- GRAIN BELT EXPRESS UPDATE Missouri regulators have blocked approval of the Grain Belt Express transmission line. The Missouri Public Service Commission's 3-2 vote to deny the Grain Belt Express project's route could derail the entire line, which already won approval from Kansas and Indiana, according to STLToday.com.
- NON-METRO LOSS Earlier this week, we told you about the general population loss in non-metro rural counties. In Illinois, only 2 non-metro counties in the state saw population growth between 2010 and 2014. They are Warren and Effingham counties.

- SKIM OR 1% A survey by USDA's Economic Research Service finds two out of five households now serve 1% or skim milk to their family. That's up by four percentage points from 2007.
- ESTATE PLANNING UPDATE The Wall Street Journal reports the U.S. Treasury Department is zeroing in on new regulations that would effectively raise the taxable value of assets transferred into family partnerships and LLCs, currently granted a discount. Speculation is that the new rules will be announced in early September. Partnerships and LLCs allow families to tax-efficiently pass on to heirs.
- RIVER UPDATE Grain sources say swift currents have prompted continued restrictions on barge tow sizes along the Illinois and sections of the Mississippi rivers.
- HOME VALUES AND THE WEB Real-estate agents across
  the country say buyers are turning their noses up at homes
  without fast Web access. A nationwide study released on
  Monday by researchers at the University of Colorado and
  Carnegie Mellon University finds fiber-optic connections
  can add \$5,437 to the price of a \$175,000 home.
